

CHOULE

The Non-Royal but most Ancient Game of Crosse

At last after almost a thousand years, a book has been published about the history of the French/Belgian game of choule (jeu de crosse).

During almost seven years, Geert & Sara Nijs have researched the game that is mentioned so often, together with the games of 'kolf' and 'jeu de mail', in the many books about the history of the game of golf. The outcome of this research has been bundled in the book 'CHOULE – The Non-Royal but most Ancient Game of Crosse'.

The book written in the English language comprises 200 pages with almost 200 photographs, paintings, drawings and illuminations.

This unique book was officially introduced in September at the 3rd annual conference of the European Association of Golf Historians and Collectors (EAGHC) in Bad Ischl.
